**Family Background** : Born in 1931 in a family, where only father was alive, and was adopted by one distantly related sister who was also widow and poor.

After serving at few place of well known Jari Merchant at Surat, his father started touring all over India with samples of Jari and fabrics manufactured in Surat on commission basis. After matriculation, Mr. Jariwala also joined father's business. For further studies, he managed finance from his savings and loans from close relatives and went to U.K. for further studies.

**Activities during study period in the year 1955-56.** : He was Chairman of Overseas Student's Association in the year 1955-56 at Leeds,U.K. Lord Mayor of Leeds (U.K.) felicitated, Shri Arunbhai Jariwala along with the Office Bearer of the Association.

**Business Activities.** : After getting the Master Degree in Textile Technology, on his return from Leeds (U. K.) he joined family business of Powerloom, Warp Knitting and Crimping Units. Thereafter, processing Unit of Man-made fabrics was also started.

In the year 1959, with other well known Jari manufacturers, he established a Unit on partnership basis for manufacturing Metallic Yarn from Plastic Sheets. This Unit was the first of its kind in the whole of India. During the year 1958, he had taken training to run the machinery which was purchased from U. K. In India this was the first Industry established at Surat. Today the business of Metallic Yarn has developed not only in Surat but in entire country. In the year 1964, due to some circumstances, he got himself relieved from this Partnership business.

After words, besides the family business, he also joined as Technical Advisor to Surat Textile Mills Ltd. and worked as technical Advisor from 1958 to 1978. He was also Chief Executive in Rajkot Spinning & Weaving Mills, a subsidiary of the above Company from 1960 to 1966. During this period he had also worked as Textile Consultant to M/s. Garden Silk Mills, Surat.

**Participation in Surat Junior Chamber.** : He played a leading role in establishing “**Surat Junior Chamber Chapter**” in Surat. He was Vice President in the year 1962 and was President in the year 1964. During his tenure as president he had organized an exhibition of Trade & Industry at Sir J. J. Sorabjee Training College which was inaugurated by the Chairman of Baroda Rayon Corporation Shri Babubhai Chinoi and valedictory function was attended by Shri Morarjibhai Desai, the then Hon’ble Union Finance Minister. Hon’ble Chief Minister of Gujarat State Shri Hitendrabhai Desai and other dignitaries also visited the exhibition. He was awarded and honoured as Senator by J. C. international Organisation.

**Surat Productivity Council.** : He was President of Surat Productivity Council in the year 1965. During his tenure of continuous three years, he provided free technical services to Small Scale Industries of Surat and set an example.

**Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry.** : He was president of Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry in the year 1975-76. During his Vice-Presidentship in the year 1975, under the able leadership of the then President Shri Dahyabhai Patel, the Trade Exhibition was organized at Surat. On the valedictory function of above exhibition, Shri H. M. Trivedi, the then Minister of State for Shipping & Transport had addressed the gathering.

At that time the biggest problem for weavers was 120% high duty on viscose yarn which was their main raw material. Their sale was adversely affected by high cost and high sale prices. Due to forceful representation made by him to Shri Morarjibhai Desai, the then Hon’ble Prime Minister of India and Shri H. M. Patel, the then Finance Minister, Government of India, this import duty was reduced to zero percentage. The weavers increased their production and sold the viscose fabrics at a very reasonable price. The poorest of poor person could enjoy the luxury of weaving silk fabrics.

During his tenure as President, several outstanding personalities addressed members of Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry. Few of them were Shri H. M. Patel former Finance Minister, Shri Purushottam Mavlanker, M. P; Shri Babubhai Jasbhai Patel, the then Chief Minister of Gujarat State, Shri H. M. Trivedi the then Minister of State for Shipping & Transport etc.

**Project under taken by SGCCI for building exhibition centre etc;** : In the year 2003-2004, the Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry decided to build a fairly large size Exhibition Centre including facilities for Buyer & Seller’s Meet and an Auditorium Building with the modern equipments and facilities for the benefit of trade and industry. The Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry requested the State Government to allot some land at the concessional rate. The State Government agreed with the proposal with a condition that SGCCI form the “Trust” with the above charitable objectives.

Shri Jariwala was the “Settler” of this Trust from his initial contribution in 2003-2004.

The Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry then approached the Ministry of Commerce for some contribution under their ILUS Scheme. The proposal was approved by the Commerce Ministry with the main condition to form SPV. The Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry formed SPV viz. SAR Infacom Ltd. under Section 25 of Indian Companies Act and entrusted the Chairmanship to Mr. Jariwala to carry out the project on the some portion of the land of the above mentioned Trust.

The first part of Building viz. the fully air conditioned exhibition Dome without any pillar in the open built up area and the same has been utilized from last 1½

years for arranging a dozen exhibitions by the Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry and other industry organizations.

The second part of the project viz. the auditorium building is in progress.

**His activities with Affiliated Trade & Industrial Organization. :** **The Surat Art Silk Cloth Manufacturers Association. (SASCMA).**

This Surat Art Silk Cloth Manufacturers Association (SASCMA), is an apex body in whole over Gujarat State. It represents the interest of over 6,00,000 Powerlooms. Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala had joined this Organisation in the year 1967 as a Director and had become Chairman in the year 1975 from where he is actively associated.

The manufacturing of Synthetic Filament Yarns like Polyester Filament Yarn, Nylon Filament Yarn were in the hands of few manufacturers only. Hence, the markets were totally controlled by them and weavers and users were exploited. Along-with other Association, The Surat Art Silk Cloth Manufacturers Association (SASCMA) under the able leadership of Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala had suggested for a new body to deal with this situation and a body viz. Man Made Industrial Co-Operative Society Ltd. MYCOSAL was formed and efforts were made to produce these yarns in the co-operative sector.

In view of strong representation to state and central governments the Central Government agreed to establish a new manufacturing Company viz. M/s. Petrofils Co-Operative Ltd. It was the intention of the Government to have participation of all Associations and Societies all over India. Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala was appointed by the central Government in this Company, as Director during the year 1976 to 2001, as weavers' representative.

During his tenure as Director, in order to make Polyester yarn available to weavers at reasonable price, he proposed and got sanctioned a **"sales scheme"** for members Societies to give them bulk discount so that the weavers can obtain the yarn at discounted rate from their members societies.

Gujarat State had agreed for the formation of Gujarat Nylons Ltd; to manufacture Nylon Filament Yarn by Gujarat Industrial Investment Corporation (GIIC) in joint collaboration with MYCOSOL. Gujarat Government appointed Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala as Director in this Company as representative of MYCOSOL.

**The Surat Art Silk Cloth Producers Co-Operative Society Ltd. :** In the larger interest of use of raw material i.e. Man Made Filament Yarn, M/s. Petrofils Co-Operative Ltd. Came into existence as mentioned earlier.

However, the Surat Art Silk Cloth Manufacturers Association (SASCMA) was registered under Section 25 of the Indian Companies Act and due to this, their members could not participate. In order to obviate this situation, the Surat Art Silk Cloth Manufacturers Association (SASCMA), established a Co-Operative Society in the name and style of "The Surat Art Silk Cloth Producers Co-Operative Society Ltd." in the year 1975 for the benefit of the members of The Surat Art Silk Cloth Manufacturers Association to purchase yarn from M/s. Petrofils Co-op. Ltd; and at a later date from M/s. Gujarat Nylons Ltd;

The reserve of this Society as on today has reached to Rs.49,11,855/- and financial assistance rose to Rs.1,46,31,000/-.

The Art Silk and Man Made fibre fabrics manufacturers found it difficult to sell their products at remunerative prices due to no availability of traders market.

Few leaders including Shri Arunchandra Jariwala took initiative to build a Surat Textile Market with 1008 shops to be allotted to traders who were carrying out their business from their residence. There are more than 200 Textile markets either on co-op. basis or ownership basis.

**SASCMA Man-Made Textile Testing & Research Association.** : With a view to assist those engaged in the manufacturing of Man Made Yarn fabrics an Institution named SASCMA Man-made Textile Testing & Research Association was established in 1974 by The Surat Art Silk Cloth Manufacturers Association.

The main idea in establishing this research Centre was to provide testing facilities for yarns, fibres, fabrics, chemicals etc. This was required in the upliftment of the quality of fabrics manufactured and processed in Dyeing Printing Houses. Also, this organization undertook applied research projects to help the industry.

This research organisation was registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 and Society Registration Act, 1860 on 02-03-1974.

This research organization was given recognition by New Delhi Department of Science & Technology. The Ministry of Finance, Delhi had under Income Tax Act, Section 35 had accorded full Tax exemption to this organization on all donation received by them.

**Establishment of Man Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA)** : Research organization like ATIRA, BITRA, SASMIRA were working under the supervision of Union Textile Ministry with substantial financial support. Shri Nanubhai Nichhabhai Patel, M.P. and Shri Golandaz, M.P. at that time represented to the central government that SASCMA Man-Made Textile Testing & Research Association centre should be recognized by Textile Ministry.

Thus, on 15-03-1981 under the name of "Man Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA) was established. Shri Arunbhai Jariwala was at that time appointed as Vice Chairman. Subsequently in the year 2009, he was nominated as Chairman.

Shri Arunbhai is one of the initiator of establishment of Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA) in Surat. Entire development of Man-Made Textile in Surat is due to the upliftment of knowledge of Textile due to the research programmes and educational and activities at Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA) due to Shri Arunbhai's vision of the future of Synthetics Textile Industry. Shri Arunbhai was specially invited by Government of India Ministry of Textile to be the members of Expert Committee of Textile policy headed by Mr. S. Sathyam, who appreciated Shri Arunbhai for the knowledge of textiles and formulation of the Textile Policy of India. Out of this another committee namely Expert Committee on Technical Textile was also formed to formulate the Technical Textile Policy. It is Shri Arunbhai's vision on Technical Textiles, when technical textiles was not known to India and this visionary man helped to the great extent to formulate the entire policy giving full details of all sectors of Technical Textiles. At present it has become known to the entire Textile Industry. Shri Arunbhai's this work will be known for the long time to come, as Technical Textile is going to take the major roll of development in future for which Shri Arunbhai will be remembered for a long time. Some people become leaders but Shri Arunbhai is visionary leader. Shri Arunbhai was entrusted by Ministry of Textile, Government of India to establish Indian Technical Textile Association at Mumbai when he was the founder Chairman.

As a president of Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA), Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA) has developed and has become the Research Organization which is appreciated in Government of India and Government of Gujarat. Under the leadership of Shri Arunbhai, Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA) was entrusted the Center of Excellence in Technical Textiles by Government of Gujarat, Center of Excellence in agro textile by Ministry of Textile, Government of India. Under his guidance all the facilities of testing of Yarn, Fabrics, Chemicals and process alongwith the environment labs, energy labs and Eco labs have been established in Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA). By his work and vision, Shri Arunbhai is respected much in Government of Gujarat & Government of India so that any propose put forward by Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA) under his leadership is generally accepted or rather Government of Gujarat or Government of India emphasizes to give the responsibility to Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA).

Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA) also took the responsibility of Integrated Skill Development Scheme (ISDS) sponsored by the Ministry of Textiles Government of India. Under the Scheme, a new building at Pandesara has been built-up to accommodate the spun-bond, non-woven, machinery and Textile Processing Machineries. Shri Arunbhai's vision was to educate the employees and employers on the technical aspects of machineries of processing houses situated at Pandesara as well as different training courses for Technical Textiles so that their skill is developed and uplifted to give better fabrics.

Anybody will be surprised to note that Shri Arunbhai took much pain to establish non-woven machineries for all the bonding Technologies. This can be done only by such technocrat like Shri Arunbhai. This will give the knowledge to everybody, how all technologies can be integrated. This plant has been thought out after few discussions on all the Technical aspects of the Machinery. You can say this is the unique plant of non-woven technologies of different kinds.

Under his leadership Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA) is recognized and accredited by National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL) and due to this National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL) accreditation, the testing reports are always accepted for the purpose of standardization and qualities tested at Man-Made Textile Research Association (MANTRA). Which reports is very essential for export of Fabrics.

**Man Made Weaving Industry Welfare & Relief Trust.**

: On 20-02-1982 under the Bombay Sarvajanic Trust Act, 1950, Section 29 the Man Made Weaving Industry Welfare & Relief Trust was established. Shri Arunbhai Jariwala has remained Managing Trustee of this Trust till date. The main objective of the trust was to establish Textile Educational Institutions and to promote the textile products of this area and also to help the activities of **MANTRA**.

**Up till now the assistance has been extended by the above Trust to MANTRA and educational institutions and other institution to the extent of more than Four Crores Rupees.**

Man Made Weaving Industries Welfare & Relief Trust (MMWIRT) and The Surat Art Silk Cloth Manufacturers Association (SASCMA) will continue to donate between Rs.25 Lakhs to Rs. 50 Lakhs as per their income.

**Shri Arun Jariwala's Contribution Surat Citizen Council.** : Surat Citizen Council is an organization for representing the public opinion and grievances. Shri Arunchandra Jariwala was Chairman for two years in this Council.

**Federation of Indian Art Silk weaving industry (FIASWI).** : Federation of Indian art silk weaving industry was established at Mumbai in the year 1977. Prior to this in the year 1968-69 under the name of All India Co-Ordination Committee the activities for representing issues of power loom and Textile industries were being discussed by the members. Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala was included as a representative of this co-ordination committee from The Surat Art Silk Cloth Manufacturers Association (SASCMA).

In FIASWI (Federation of Indian art silk weaving Industry) several issues being discussed by members at their Managing committee meetings. The Annual General Meeting is being held in different states at places like Bangalore, Salem, Mumbai, Coimbatore etc; The Textile Commissioner and leading industrialist with outstanding abilities preside over such meetings.

**Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala is Chairman of FIASWI since the year 1995 till date.**

**Formation of Indian Technical Textile Association (ITTA) April 2010:** : The concept of Technical Textiles was first deliberated by Shri A. N. Jariwala in the meeting of Expert Committee on Textile Policy.

The Committee accepted the importance of development and growth of Technical Textile and made strong recommendation to Textile Industry to undertake this activity.

Shri Aruchnadra N. Jariwala was appointed as chief convener of the Development council formed by Textile Commissioner. The council contacted the existing playas in this field and also new entrepreneurs along with TRAS and consultant.

The Council decided to formed an Association of these persons and prepare a memorandum of articles with developmental objects like in case of NASCOM of I. T. Industry.

**The role of Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala has been pivotal in this direction as the Registration of this Association with the Registrar of Companies under section 25 of the Companies Act 1956, have been completed. Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala was nominated as Chairman of this Association.**

**FIASWI and SASCMA Chairman appointment on various committees:** : Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala as chairman of SASCMA and FIASWI has been appointed on the following committees by union Textile Ministry.

- (1) Member on Expert Committee for Growth & Development of Technical Textile, reconstituted by Ministry of Textiles.
- (2) Member on Development Council for Textile Industry.
- (3) Member on Development Council for the Schedule Industries engaged in the manufacturer or production of Textile Machinery.

- (5) Member on the Technical Advisory Committee for Technology Up-gradation Fund (T.U.F.) since 1999 when it was first established.
- (6) Member of Advisory Board – Nodal Centre for Up-gradation of Textile Education, IIT, New Delhi.
- (7) Member of the Mira Sheth High Power Committee appointed by the Government for the upliftment of Handlooms as a technical advisor.
- (8) Member on the Textile Committee – Ministry of Textiles and its various Sub Committees.
- (9) Member of the Council of Synthetic & Rayon Textile Export Promotion Council, Mumbai.
- (10) Member on the Public Grievance Committee and Regional Advisory Committee formed by the local Central Excise & Customs authorities, Surat, since 1975.
- (11) Member on Working Group for Development of Power loom and Processing Sector of Gujarat State, constituted by Industry & Mines Dept. Government of Gujarat.
- (12) Member on Market Access of Textile Products for entering in to PTA & FTA with other countries.
- (13) Member on the Development Council for the Schedule Industries engaged in the Manufacturer or production of Textile Machinery.
- (14) Member on Expert Committee for Growth & Development of Technical Textile, reconstituted by Ministry of Textiles.

**Textile Association (India)** : Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala is a life member of Textile Association (India). He was chairman of South Gujarat units, one mega international Textile Conference was organized by him in the year 1985 where 2500 members had participated. Shri Dhirubhai Ambani renowned industrialist had inaugurated this conference. Shri Amarsingh Choudhry the then Chief Minister of Gujarat State had presided over this function.

**Udhna Udyognagar Sahakari Sangh** : With 255 Acre land in the year 1957 small as well as medium scale enthusiastic entrepreneurs had formed **UDHNA UDYOGNAGAR SAHAKARI SANGH**. Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala as Chairman had organized several amenities and evolved a complex on Modern slandered. This has costed Rs.12 crores. Besides this proper drainage and water supply system was arranged.

Besides this, Shri Arunchandra N. Jariwala was President / Chairman in Udhna Udyognagar Charitable Trust, Udhna Academy Education Trust, Sarvajanic Education Society, Surat Textile Market and South Gujarat Processors Association.

Mr. Jariwala had deep interest in women's education and he was chairman of the managing committee and now president since long of the **Vidhya Mandir Society, education Trust**.

**His contribution in various activities and promotion of new norms for the development of organization was very much useful.**

**Appreciations** : The work performance of Shri Arunchandra Jariwala was appreciated at various stages and also by Gujarat Government and Union Textile Ministry. Some of the extract of such appreciation have been grouped as under:

- a) Expert Committee on Textile Policy constituted by Union Textile Ministry in the year 1998.

In this Committee report for the present Textile Policy a detailed observation and recommendation of the Committee have been included. The appreciation made by Mr. S. Sathyam, IAS. Chairman of the Expert Committee has been given below:

**“It will be an unforgivable lapse of mine if I do not single out Shri A. N. Jariwala’s name for special admiration. Having been a member of most of the Committees appointed in this sector, he was the bulwark of our bastion and the corner-stone of all our consultations. A technocrat by training, a weaver by profession, a sadhu by temperament, and a helper by instinct, he was present everywhere at all times to help everyone notwithstanding his old age, ill-health, and inconvenient location.
